Excellency,

I am mandated by the C-10 to respond to your letter of 18 August, 2011, offering those Member States who have come up with initiatives during this Session, to forward by Tuesday, 6 September, 2011, any document outlining the said initiatives and their results, for you to share them with the entire membership, in the spirit of transparency.

I wish to inform you that the C-10 is still holding consultations, and is very much open to further consultations with such interest groups who have come up or are likely to come up with initiatives on Security Council reform; and will in due course of time, as a consequence, outside the stipulated time frame you have indicated, apprise you with the outcome of such consultations.

We will unreservedly continue to support your Chairmanship and will strive to work with you to ensure that the process remains open, transparent, inclusive and comprehensive and lead towards the success of the intergovernmental negotiations for an early comprehensive reform of the Security Council.

We remain confident that the African Common Position as contained in Ezulwini consensus and Sirte declaration continues to enjoy broad support of the general membership.
